at the Addison Gallery of American Art (3 Chapel Ave, Andover, MA). This event is free and open to the public; all ages are welcome.

Sumi Ink Club is a participatory drawing project founded in 2005 by Los Angeles-based artists Sarah Rara and Luke Fischbeck. Employing the brush and black ink of traditional sumi ink wash painting, the club produces work in open-to-the-public meetings in which people of all ages and skill are invited to contribute to a collaborative drawing. Using group drawing as a means to generate social interactions and sustain community connections, it is the artists' hope that each drawing reflects the diversity of participants as well as the conversations and exchanges that occurred during its making. Visitors are invited to join the artists for open drawing sessions, with the finished wall mural being unveiled at the opening reception on Friday, January 26 (6:00–8:00 pm) and will remain on view through the summer.
