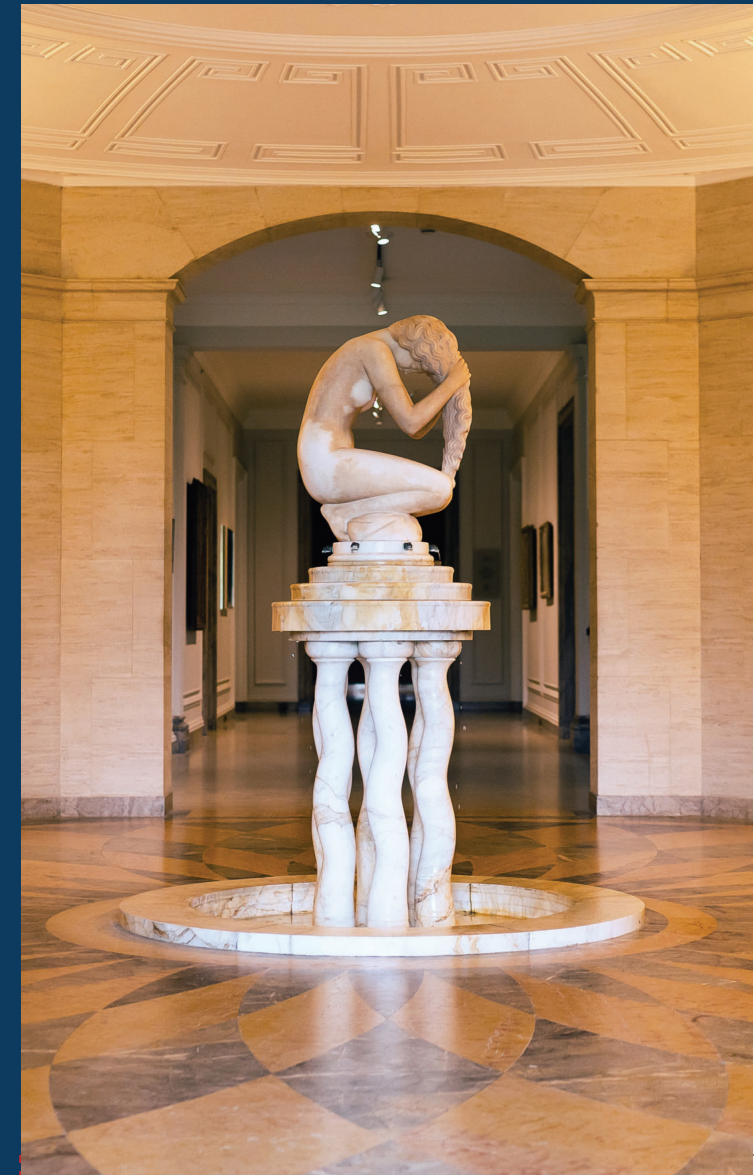

Exhibitions

The Addison Artist Council (AAC) is an initiative supported by contemporary art enthusiasts who help award the biannual Bartlett H. Hayes Jr. Prize, which gives an artist their first museum solo show, an accompanying publication, an artist's residency, and an acquisition of their work for the Addison's collection.
